I personally am being impacted on a near daily basis with the following:

- 1) Closure of hiking trails to non-guided hikers at the Mendenhall Glacier.
- 2) Continuous helicopter noise in the Mendenhall Valley.
- 3) Boat wakes from whale watching boats in Auke Bay. Whale watching boats should be limited in speed to 8 knots and they should not be allowed to pass through the narrow channel on the north end of Coglin Island.
