

# DURING SCHOOL CLOSURE, DISTRICT PROVIDES FREE MEALS TO STUDENTS

For families using school food services, the Juneau School District (JSD) is providing free food through Friday, March 27. Food is available for any child 18 years of age or younger at established food service sites. Students over 18 enrolled in the JSD are also eligible. Students must be present when picking up the food. First Student buses will be located in the parking lots of each distribution site (see list below). First Student staff will provide pre-packaged breakfast and lunch meals. Small groups will be maintained in the process to minimize the gathering of crowds as students receive their take-home meals. Any student can pick up food at any site; they don't have to go to their regular school.






# HAND WASHING




Wet hands with water.




Apply enough soap to cover all hand surfaces.




Rub hands together in a circle.




Put one palm on top the other hand and rub soap up and down.




Put palms and fingers together and rub soap up and down.




Put fingers of both hands together and rub soap up and down.




Clean thumbs by rubbing each one around several times with the other palm.




Clean both palms by rubbing soap around palm with fingers of the other hand.




Rinse hands with water.



Dry hands completely using a single use towel.



Use towel to turn off faucet and throw it away.
