



Phase-In: Phase Three

Updated August 31st, 2020

The Division of Aquatics has worked diligently toward welcoming patrons back in the facility with modifications to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Operations will continue in Phase III of reopening, with the addition of Augustus Brown Swimming Pool on September 8th, 2020. Information on operational and schedule changes are provided below.

Dimond Park Aquatic Center will continue to operate in Phase III. Please note, lap lane availability will decrease with the addition of the two high school teams (TMHS 5:15am-7:15am & JDHS 5:30pm-7:30pm)

Amenities Offered in Phase III

- Drop-in recreation continues; recreating on a reservation only basis is no longer in effect
- Locker rooms will stay open for public use
 - Showers will be available for use at both facilities starting September 8th
- Fitness deck will reopen; allowing no more than three patrons at any given time
- Full Lap Pool – maximum of one household per lane
- Full Rec Pool – lane lines will remain in place of the back corner for water walking and lap swimming

Amenities Offline in Phase III

- Hot tub and sauna
- Slides, spray features, and diving boards
- Lobby tables and chairs (no loitering)
- Open swims
- Fitness Classes

Facility Guidelines

1. Employees will continue wear face coverings while directly dealing with the public, and when 6 ft. of distance cannot be maintained among another staff member.
2. Per ***CBJ Emergency Ordinance No. 2020-05*** members of the public are still required to wear face coverings in our common spaces (lobby, front desk, and locker rooms/restrooms). Face coverings will be provided. All face covering exemption inquiries should be directed to Kollin.Monahan@juneau.org
3. Social distancing of at least six feet should be maintained between individuals and household groups when in the common spaces as well as the natatorium.
 - i. Plastic “sneeze guards” are installed at the front desk, and in between each lane to allow for an extra degree of separation where distancing is not possible.
 - ii. Floor stanchions and markings will be installed to direct flow of traffic when entering and exiting aquatic facilities.

Hygiene & Cleaning Measures

1. Aquatics staff will wash their hands frequently and pool patrons are encouraged to do the same.
2. Hand sanitizer will be available upon arrival.
3. The fitness deck, locker & family changing rooms will be wiped down at the top of every hour.
4. The entire facility will be closed to the public to be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected prior to open, during the mid-day closure, and at close to provide a safe and sanitized facility.
5. No member of the public displaying symptoms of COVID-19 may be present in public facilities.
