I own and operate a medical massage business in Juneau, AK. Per State Mandate, I was shut down for 6 weeks starting March 25, 2020. I had zero income during that time. Since being able to start working again, State Mandate 15 has made it so I am limited to how many patients I can see in a day, due to extra protocol and social distancing requirements. As a result, I am working longer hours in order to maintain a decent income, and spending exponentially more on PPE and cleaning products. Tourism does not affect my business, as I work almost solely with medically prescribed patients, so the biggest loss was during the 2nd quarter. I lost 50% of my revenue during the 2nd quarter. 3rd quarter, on paper, my numbers and income look similar to 3rd quarter of 2019, but I am having to work 25% more hours in order to maintain this income. This doesn't get noticed on paper or on a tax return, but it has caused immense stress and fatigue that I wouldn't and shouldn't have to deal with.

Any financial help at this point would be greatly appreciated. All small businesses are struggling.
